Prayer made in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of FIR No.0055 dated 06.10.2015 qua the petitioner, for offence under Sections 120-B, 406, 409, 420, 465, 467, 468, 471, 473 and 474 IPC and all other consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

On 24.12.2015, this Court while issuing notice of motion for today, has passed the following order:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is M.D. and C.E.O. of Axis Bank, whereas the irregularity, if any, has been committed by the branch officials at Panchkula.

Notice of motion for 18.2.2016.”

In response thereto, reply by way of affidavit of Purnima Singh HPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, Panchkula on behalf of respondent No.1-State of Haryana has filed.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI-Partap Singh, while referring para No.4 of the said reply states that the present petition is premature and liable to be dismissed on the ground that investigation in the case has not yet been completed. Even till date, the petitioner has not been called to join investigation or to give specimen handwriting or signatures.

In view of the reply and submissions made by learned counsel for the State, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition at this stage being premature, however, seeks liberty that in case the petitioner is required to be associated with the investigation, she be served with a notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C.

Dismissed as premature with liberty as aforesaid.
