KULDIP SINGH, J (ORAL)

The present petition has been filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 182 dated 25.09.2004 (*Annexure P-1*) registered under Sections 420/406 IPC at Police Station Model Town, Ludhiana on the basis of compromise dated 20.07.2015 (*Annexure P-2*).

Report received from the learned Judicial Magistrate, Ist Class, Ludhiana, wherein it is stated the FIR against the accused namely Harbhajan Singh, Sandeep Kumar, Tejinder Singh, Jaswinder Singh, Hardeep Singh was quashed by this Court vide order dated 16.11.2015 against the remaining accused except accused Jaswinder Singh. Complainant Kashmir Singh and Sodhi Singh as well as Jaswinder Singh has made statement before the learned magistrate that they have amicably

compromised the dispute. It is reported that the said compromise is without any coercion, pressure or undue influence.

In view of the fact that the parties have amicably settled their dispute, FIR No. 182 dated 25.09.2004 registered under Sections 420/406 IPC at Police Station Model Town, Ludhiana against the present petitioner Jaswinder Singh, and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, stand quashed.
