**This order will dispose of CrI. Misc. Nos. 44993, 45011 and
45037 of 2016 together as common questions of law and facts are involved
in all the petitions being arisen out of one FIR.**

All these petitions under Section 439 Cr.P.C are for grant of

regular bail to the petitioner(s) in case F.I.R No. 29 dated 26.03.2016, under Section 306 IPC, registered at Police Station, Sangat, Bathinda.

Petitioners Harjit Singh and Harmandeep Kaur @ Mannu are in custody since 28.03.2016, whereas Gurpyar Singh is in custody since 02.04.2016.

As per suicide note (Annexure P-1), deceased-Charanjit Kaur had stated that she was made accused of stealing a SIM, which contained her recording. She has further given the names of Gurpyar Singh, Sikander Singh, Harmandeep Kaur and Harjit Singh, who had defamed her, which compelled her to commit suicide.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, has informed the Court that handwriting on the suicide note has been compared and it has been found to be written by Charanjit Kaur-deceased. After framing of charges, only 07 witnesses are remained to be examined.

Heard.

Keeping in view the period of incarceration of the petitioner(s) and the fact that trial may still take some time for its conclusion, this court feels that there is no need to detain the petitioner(s) any longer. Accordingly, all these petitions i.e. Crl. Misc. Nos. 44993, 45011 and 45037 of 2016 are allowed and petitioner(s) are ordered to be enlarged on bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Bathinda.
