By this petition the petitioner has sought directions to the official respondents to carry out the investigation fairly and impartially in FIR No.335 dated 28.08.2016 registered under Section 61 of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914 and Section 22 of the N.D.P.S. Act, at Police Station A-Division, Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in this

connection the petitioner has also moved a representation dated 30.08.2016 (Annexure P-2) and at this stage he would be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.2 – Director General of Police, Punjab to look into the matter and take appropriate action on his representation within any reasonable time.

I find this to be a fair request. The respondent No.2 is directed to look into the matter and in case it is found that any action is required, to take whatever action he deems necessary as per law.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
