Petitioner apprehends arrest in a case registered under Section 27 of the Drugs and Cosmetics Act. The search was conducted by Drug Inspector along with the police officials and some medicines containing steroids were recovered from the place belonging to petitioner.

The petitioner has been involved in the case on the basis of statement of one Amarjit Singh to the effect that some portion of the building has been rented out to the petitioner.

Commission of any offence under the NDPS Act is not apparent. The petitioner has already joined investigation. It does not appear to be a case of custodial interrogation as the recoveries have already been effected.

The petition is allowed. It is ordered that in case of arrest of the petitioner, he shall be released on bail to the satisfaction of the arresting officer subject to the conditions that he will join investigation as and when required and will not tamper with the evidence or hamper investigation, in any manner.
