JASWANT SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Prayer is for grant of regular bail on behalf of the petitioner in case FIR No. 119, dated 07.10.2012, for offences punishable under Sections 15/61/85 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, registered at Police Station Lohian, District Jalandhar.

As per allegations, there was a recovery of 60 kgs of poppy husk from a motor-cycle belonging to the accused/petitioner and the petitioner-accused alongwith his co-accused-Nimma fled away from the spot.

It is contended that the petitioner was declared proclaimed offender and was taken in custody in the month of July 2014. Co-accused-Nimma is stated to have convicted for three years.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by ASI Shailender Singh, does not refute the aforesaid factual position and states that prosecution evidence in the present case is over. He further submits that the case is now listed for recording of statement of accused/petitioner under Section 313 Cr.P.C. before the trial Court.

In view of the advanced stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
