The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.324, dated 4.10.2015, registered under Sections 148, 149, 364, 365, 302, 427, 201, 216 of the IPC, at Police Station Sadar Sirsa.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that similarly situated co-accused have been granted the concession of regular bail by this Court vide order dated 22.11.2016 (Annexure P-6), and the petitioner has

now been in custody for more than 14 months.

Learned Addl. AG Punjab has, however, argued that the only distinction is that the petitioner had stabbed the deceased but has accepted that he was not named in the FIR and now the complainant and the eye witnesses have exculpated him.

In these circumstances, I do not deem it appropriate to take a different view. Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands disposed of.
