For the reasons recorded, this application is allowed and the documents (Annexures P-5 and P-6) are taken on record.

The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.181, dated 23.8.2014, registered under Sections 148, 149, 307, 302 of the IPC and Sections 25/54/59 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Baroda, District Sonapat.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the petitioner has

now been in custody since 25.8.2014 and the eye witnesses have resiled.

Learned DAG Haryana, on instructions from ASI Naresh Kumar, has accepted these factual assertions.

In these circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.
