Affidavit filed by Karanjeet Singh, petitioner no.2, in Court today, is taken on record.

Harpreet Kaur and Karanjeet Singh, the petitioners before me, claim themselves to be major. They have pleaded that they have married against the wishes of respondent No.4 and seek protection to their life and liberty. They apprehend danger from respondent no.4. They have placed on record marriage certificate and photographs, Annexures P-3, P-4 and P-5, respectively evidencing their marriage. Both the petitioners are present. Petitioner no.1 is specifically stated that she is major and married with petitioner no.2 on her own will and without any pressure. The petitioners have submitted a representation to the Police Post Head, Chowki Karan Sahab, District Kurukshetra, Annexure P-6.

Without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, I dispose of the petition with directions to respondent no.2 to direct the Police Post Head, Chowki Karan Sahab, District Kurukshetra, to decide the representation of the petitioners, Annexure P-6, within a period of one month and grant them protection, if any threat to their life and liberty is perceived. It is made clear that this

order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law if any committed by them.
