KULDIP SINGH, J (ORAL)

The prayer in this present petition filed under Section 482 of Cr. P.C is for quashing of FIR No. 239 dated 11.11.2006 (*Annexure P-1*) registered under Sections 420, 120-B of IPC at Police Station Sadar Ludhiana, District Ludhiana alongwith all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom qua the petitioner, on the basis of compromise deed dated 11.05.2015 (*Annexure P-2*).

Report of the learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Ludhiana, has been received wherein it has been reported that the statements of the complainant namely Khushkismat Singh and accused namely Joginder Kaur Sandhu have been recorded to the effect that compromise has been effected between the parties. It is further reported that the said compromise is voluntary and is without any coercion, pressure or undue influence.

The learned State counsel has stated that in this case two persons were challaned namely Joginder Kaur Sandhu-present petitioner and one Gurmeet Singh. It is further contended that there is no compromise with the other accused-Gurmeet Singh.

The perusal of the FIR shows that it was a money dispute which has been amicably settled by the parties.

Since, the parties have amicably settled their money dispute, therefore, FIR No. 239 dated 11.11.2006 (*Annexure P-1*) registered under Sections 420, 120-B of IPC at Police Station Sadar Ludhiana, District Ludhiana qua the petitioner-Joginder Kaur Sandhu only, stands quashed alongwith all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of the compromise (*Annexure P-2*).

It is further ordered that the trial against the co-accused-Gurmeet Singh shall continue.

In view of the above, the present petition stands allowed.
