Pursuant to the notice issued to the U.T. Chandigarh, learned counsel for U.T. Chandigarh has submitted that the petitioner is an accused in FIR No. 128 dated 29.07.2016 registered under Sections 409, 420, 120 B IPC and 8, 9, 13 (1) (d) read with Section 13 (2) of Prevention of Corruption Act at Police Station, Sector 11, Chandigarh and is not required as an accused in any other registered criminal case.

Further, he has submitted that the U.T. Administration has planned to file an application for cancellation of bail of the petitioner under Section 439 (2) Cr.P.C in the aforesaid case.

This petition is disposed of with a direction that in case, the petitioner is required in any other criminal case registered pertaining to

leakage of examination papers by the Chandigarh Police, he would be entitled to notice under Section 160 Cr.P.C for a period of at least three days.
