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**JASWANT SINGH, J (ORAL)**

Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Yogesh in case FIR No.315 dated 15.6.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 323, 325, 506 of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station DLF-II, Gurgaon.

The occurrence is of 13.6.2015 at around 8.00 pm leading to recording of an FIR No.313 dated 14.6.2015 by Shiv Charan father of the present petitioner-Yogesh. The said FIR No.313 is for offences under Sections 148, 149, 323, 506 and 307 of Indian Penal Code and Section 25/54/59 of Arms Act (Annexure P-1) against Ramkala, Hari Singh @ Chinu and Karan Singh @ Golu. Hari Singh @ Chinu fired shot from his

pistol which struck on thigh of Shiv Charan.

It is averred that as a counter-blast, the aforesaid Ramkala lodged the present FIR No.315 on the next day with the allegations of having inflicted injuries and also threatening to kill.

It is contended that the petitioner is 23 years old student and studying at Pune and has been falsely implicated with a false version of having inflicted a knife injury on the back of Ramkala, which is not supported by the medical evidence. It is further contended that in the said FIR No.315, father of the petitioner, namely, Shiv Charan and two other accused persons have also been arrested.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel assisted by ASI Raj Pal submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 06<sup>th</sup> of January, 2016 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
