Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Prem Kumar in case FIR No.233 dated 18.11.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 307, 323, 324 and 34 of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Sadar, Jagraon, District Ludhiana, Punjab.

As per the version of the complainant-Charanjit Singh, the petitioner-accused Prem Kumar along with his son/co-accused Sandeep Kumar and two unidentified persons had gone to the brick kiln on 18.11.2015 and caused injuries to the complainant.

The co-accused Sandeep Kumar is alleged to have inflicted two sword blows on the head, one unidentified person gave sword blow on the right finger of the complainant and the petitioner-accused Prem Kumar gave baseball blows on the arms and legs of the complainant.

It is submitted that the petitioner is 71 years old heart patient and has been falsely implicated due to a litigation between son-Sandeep Kumar of the petitioner and the employer-Raman Kumar of the complainant.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel assisted by ASI Baldev Singh submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 24th of December, 2015 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
