Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Raghbir Singh in Complaint Case No.6 dated 09.01.2010 under Sections 365, 341, 420, 406, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC titled as Ashwani Kumar Vs. Banarsi Dass pending in the Court of learned JMIC, Khanna, wherein he has been summoned to face trial.

Complainant Ashwani Kumar alleges that the present accused Raghbir Singh along with others had under coercion got an agreement to sell dated 23.4.2009 regarding sale of land executed in favour of one Banarsi Dass by the wife of the complainant namely Sama Rani. The suit for specific performance based on the agreement to sell has resulted into a decree in favour of the co-accused Banarsi Dass.

In the complaint filed on 19.01.2010 petitioner who is working

as ASI with Punjab Police along with co-accused were summoned to face trial. The petitioner has been declared proclaimed offender on 17.03.2015. The said order has been challenged by filing a revision (Annexure **P-5**) before the Sessions Court.

After hearing learned Counsel for the petitioner, no case for grant of anticipatory bail is made out since it is extremely unfortunate that a police official had to be declared as a proclaimed offender.

Dismissed.
