This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case F.I.R. No.330 dated 24.10.2014 registered under Sections 148/149/323/324/302/506 IPC at Police Station Mahesh Nagar, Ambala, District Ambala, Haryana.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has been in custody since 24.10.2014

Learned Assistant Advocate General on instructions from Investigating Officer states that only five witnesses remain to be examined and in case the petitioner does not obstruct the trial the prosecution will lead its entire evidence on or before 22.02.2017 and till such time the bail should not be granted to the petitioner.

I find this to be a fair submission. In the circumstances, in view of the undertaking given by the learned Assistant Advocate General, it is directed that in case the prosecution does not lead its entire evidence on or before 22.02.2017 (subject to the accused not obstructing the same) the petitioner be released on bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court.

Petition stands disposed of in the above terms.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
