Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondent Nos.4 to 8.

Mr. Surinder Mohan Sharma, Advocate has entered

appearance on behalf of respondents No. 4 the father of the petitioner No.-1 and prays that the father and brother may be allowed to meet with petitioner No.1.

Request has been accepted. Respondent No.4-the father of petitioner No.1 and brother of petitioner No.1 have met with petitioner No.1 in the chamber of this Court.

Even thereafter petitioner No.1 is adamant and wants to live with petitioner No.2.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. They are stated to be major. In support of her proof of age petitioner No.1 has placed on record a copy of Matriculation examination (Annexure P-1) wherein her date of birth is mentioned as 01.08.1998 whereas petitioner No.2 has also placed on record a copy of Aadhar Card (Annexure P-2) depicting his date of birth as 25.02.1995. They have also moved a representation before the Sr. Superintendent of Police, Roopnagar (Annexure P-5) for protection of their life and liberty.

Without adverting to the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-the Sr. Superintendent of Police, Roopnagar to take appropriate action on the said representation (Annexure P-5).
