Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for quashing of F.I.R. No.109 dated 21.05.2014 under Sections 15, 18, 21, 22 of NDPS Act and Section 61 of Punjab Excise Act, registered at Police Station Shahkot, District Jalandhar City.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that though the FIR was registered on 21.05.2014, but till date, no action thereof, has been informed to the petitioner. He further states that the pendency of aforesaid FIR is unnecessarily hanging in the mind of the petitioner and the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the respondent to intimate the status of aforesaid FIR to the petitioner.
