Status report filed by the State in Court, is taken on record.

The status report shows that on the complaint of the petitioner, an enquiry was conducted. As per inquiry report, a criminal case was made out against the private respondents. However, when the opinion of the District Attorney (Legal) was taken, he opined that as per Hindu Rites, marriage is valid, so, no action is required. It is also so stated that no further action is required to be taken in the matter by the local police.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to approach the Illaqa Magistrate by way of appropriate complaint, if he so desires.
