Prayer is under Section 438 Cr.PC for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner Akwinder Kaur in case FIR No.103 dated 06.06.2015 for offences punishable under Sections 406, 420, 120-B of Indian Penal Code registered with Police Station Mehatpur, District Jalandhar.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner submits that allegations in the FIR *vis-a-vis* alluring the complainant to send him abroad are totally false and baseless. The petitioner is none else but wife of Gagandeep Singh and has no role to play in the alleged commission of offence. Even otherwise before Investigating Officer, entire bank statement has been submitted to show that nothing was deposited in the bank account of the

petitioner, neither the complainant had shown any proof of *vis-a-vis* the arrangement of money of Rs.4 lacs.

Learned Counsel for the petitioner further submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sardool Singh submits that pursuant to the interim order passed by this court petitioner has joined the investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, interim protection/pre-arrest bail granted vide order dated 28th of December, 2015 is made absolute.

Petition stands disposed of.
