Prayer in this petition is for cancellation of bail granted to respondent No.2 by this Court vide order dated 31.8.2015 in CRM-M-19489 of 2015 in case FIR No.88 dated 8.4.2015 under Sections 323, 341 and 506 read with Section 34 IPC as well as Section 295-A IPC, which was added subsequently.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that apart from the fact that the alleged weapon used in the crime was not recovered, the accused are threatening the petitioner.

Heard.

Taking into consideration the fact that the offence allegedly committed by the accused are triable by Magistrate, no case for cancellation of bail is made out.

The present petition is, accordingly, dismissed.
