Petitioner seeks benefit of regular bail pending trial in case FIR No.15 dated 27.03.2014 under Section 22 of Narcotic Drugs and Pschotropic Substances Act, 1985 registered at Police Station, Bholath, District Kapurthala.

As per prosecution version, the recovery effected from the petitioner is of 160 grams intoxicant powder which upon receipt of the chemical examiner report was found containing Diphenoxylate hydrochloride.

It has gone uncontroverted that more than 50 grams of such salt falls within the purview of commercial quantity. No ground for granting bail is made out.

Petition dismissed.
