The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No.111, dated 17.6.2016, registered under Section 302/34 of the IPC, at Police Station Cantonment, District Amritsar.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that even though the case has been registered under Section 302 of the IPC but the fact of the matter is that the deceased died due to electric shock, and the petitioner has now been in custody for more than six months.

Lakhwinder Singh, has accepted these factual assertions.

In these circumstances, without commenting upon the merits of the case, and keeping in view the period of custody already suffered by the petitioner, I do not deem it appropriate to deny the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands disposed of.
