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**JASWANT SINGH, J. (Oral)**

Present petition is for grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. on behalf of the petitioner/accused-Rajender in case FIR No.288 dated 26.08.2015, under Section 20 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, registered with Police Station Kalanaur.

There is alleged recovery of 270 grams of *Charas*, which concededly is non-commercial in quantity.

The petitioner is stated to be in custody since 26.08.2015 and evidence of the prosecution witnesses is yet to commence. The petitioner is asserted to be not involved in any other case.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by ASI Dinesh Kumar, does not refute the aforesaid factual situation.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, keeping in view the custody period and the fact that trial is not likely to be concluded in near future, as also the seized quantity being non-commercial in nature, this Court finds that petitioner/accused deserves the concession of regular bail and as such he is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of CJM/Duty Magistrate concerned.
