Learned State Counsel has filed reply by way of affidavit of Jagjit Singh, Inspector General of Prisons, O/o the Director General of Prisons, Haryana, Sector 14, Panchkula on behalf of the respondents-State, today in the Court. Same is taken on record.

Keeping in view the stand of learned State Counsel which could not be controverted by learned counsel for the petitioner that in terms of Article 161 of the Constitution of India, the petitioner is supposed to directly approach His Excellency the Governor for grant of clemency.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner has made a statement before this Court withdrawing the present petition however, reserving rights of the petitioner to move the Hon'ble Governor on the same very grounds by way of emancipation directly.
