The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking issuance of directions to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to take appropriate action against respondent Nos. 4 to 7 on the representation filed by the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that a complaint/representation (Annexure P-1) has already been preferred by the petitioner to respondent No.2 on 31.10.2016 regarding demand of dowry and beatings against the private respondents, however, no action has been taken thereon. It is also argued that at the present moment only a limited prayer is made that the said representation be decided expeditiously as possible.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Arshdeep S. Kler, learned DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. Let two copies of the petition be served upon him during the course of the day. He fairly submits that the representation (Annexure P-1) will be looked into as expeditiously as possible.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation (Annexure P-1) preferred on 11.10.2016 in accordance with law expeditiously, preferably within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
