Through the instant petition, the petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in case FIR No.150 dated 18.11.2014, registered under Sections 306 IPC, Police Station Division No.6, Industrial Area, District Ludhiana.

The petitioner was directed to join the investigation. The petitioner had joined the investigation.

The State counsel states that investigation is complete but challan has not been filed.

Admittedly there was a relationship between the deceased and the petitioner. There were exchange of letters and messages (SMS). The police had sent the letters for forensic examination and report has been received. The handwriting was found to be of the deceased. No recovery is to be effected. Custodial interrogation is not required. The petitioner is ready to join the investigation.

Looking to the circumstances, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 27.01.2015

granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i)(ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
