Learned counsel after arguing for some time wishes to withdraw the petition with a liberty to take all the pleas before the trial Court.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

However, the personal appearance of the petitioners is exempted before the trial Court, subject to the following conditions:- (i) petitioners shall be represented through counsel; (ii) shall not delay/stall the trial proceedings; (iii) shall not dispute their identity as an accused; (iv) shall have no objection if the prosecution evidence is recorded in their absence but in the presence of their counsel; (v) shall appear before the trial Court as and when required by the trial Court; and (vi) any other condition which the learned trial Court may impose.
