By filing the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, the petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in case FIR No.275, dated 28.11.2015, registered under Sections 420 and 120-B IPC, at Police Station Cantonment, Amritsar City, District Amritsar.

On 30.12.2015, this Court had passed the following order:-

“Contends that it was a case of private loan which has been fully satisfied but the complainant has levelled these allegations on account of mala fide.

Notice of motion for 4.2.2016.

In the meantime, the arrest of the petitioner shall remain

stayed subject to following conditions :-

- (i)He will make himself available for investigation as and when required to do so.*
- (ii)He will not leave the country without the prior permission of the Court.;*
- (iii) He will not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the court or to any police officer”*

It is contended that in pursuance of the order dated 30.12.2015, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel, on instructions, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 30.12.2015, is made absolute, subject to the conditions contained in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition stands allowed.
