Prayer made in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of appropriate orders or directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners as they have got married on 30.12.2015, against the wishes of respondents No.4 to 7, who are parents and brothers of Amanjeet Kaur-petitioner No.1.

At the time of hearing of the present petition, respondent No.4-Teja Singh appeared in the court along with his counsel Mr. H.S.Baath, Advocate and requested for having a meeting with petitioner-Amanjeet Kaur as according to him he had accepted the fact of the petitioners being close to each other and therefore, he did not want to interfere in their life and liberty. He also stated that he would formally solemnize the marriage of his daughter Amanjeet Kaur with Budh Raj.

After Amanjeet Kaur-petitioner No.1 and Teja Singh-respondent No.4 had a meeting with each other in the Retiring Room of the Court, the court has put it to Amanjeet Kaur as to whether she is ready and

willing to her father Teja Singh formally solemnizing her marriage with Budh Raj but she stated that she still apprehends danger to her as well as Budh Raj's life and liberty at the hands of respondents No.4 to 7.

Without commenting upon the validity of the marriage of the petitioners, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Mansa to look into the grievances of the petitioners and, if need be, to take appropriate action in accordance with law.
