Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail on behalf of the petitioner in case FIR No. 176, dated 26.09.2015, for offences punishable under Sections 406 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Phase-1, District SAS Nagar.

As per allegations, petitioner-Mohan Singh Rawat, who is an agent for executing life insurance policies, had duped the complainant-Mahesh Kumar Gupta for a sum of Rs. 7 lacs (Approx.) by obtaining 'self-cheques' for renewing his expired life insurance policy.

Learned State Counsel, assisted by ASI Jaspal Singh, states that there is other case pending of similar nature against the petitioner.

Keeping in view the nature and gravity of the offence, no case for grant of anticipatory bail is made out.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
