By virtue of the instant petition preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C., petitioner has sought direction to respondent Nos. 1 to 4 to take legal action against respondent Nos.5 to 7 and further to conduct fair & impartial investigation.

Notice of motion to official respondents only at this stage.

At the asking of Court, Mr. R.P.S. Sidhu, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-Punjab. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though representation dated August 13, 2016 (Annexure P-1) was moved, but till date no substantive action has been taken by the concerned authorities.

At the very outset of the arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that she feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, District Moga (Punjab) to decide her representation dated August 13, 2016 (Annexure P-1) within a stipulated period.

The instant petition is disposed of, with a direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga (Punjab) to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in her representation dated August 13, 2016 (Annexure P-1) and if some substance is found, to take an appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
