Petitioners seek quashing of FIR No.86 dated 30.11.2016 under Sections 458/427/506/148/149 IPC registered at Police Station Dharamgarh, District Sangrur which was registered at the instance of respondent No.2-complainant Navjot Singh, on the basis of compromise.

The investigation is still in progress and challan has not been presented.

Notice to the respondents.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Harpreet Kaur Athwal, DAG, Punjab, present in the Court, accepts notice. Copy of the petition has been handed over to the State counsel.

Mr. A.S. Sandhu, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of respondent No.2-complainant and admitted that the matter has been compromised.

Since it is an assault case in which respondent No.2-complainant has put in appearance before this Court to inform that the matter has been compromised, this petition is disposed of with a direction that it will be open to the complainant or the affected/injured victim to

approach the investigating officer and offer a statement/supplementary statement. In case, the investigating officer after recording the statement/supplementary statement is of the view that challan is not required to be presented or cancellation report could be filed, it will be open to the investigating officer to do the same in accordance with law. The entire exercise will be done within a period of two months after recording supplementary statements.
