Notices could not be issued to respondent Nos.4 to 7 as learned counsel for the petitioners has not filed the process fee. Therefore, the present petition qua respondent Nos.4 to 7 stands dismissed.

Petitioner no.1, who is living in Norway and petitioner no.2, who is resident of H.No.E.A-15, Civil Lines, Qadian, Tehsil Batala have approached this court for protecting their personal lives and liberty from the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 7 and seek issuance of directions to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to prevent respondent Nos.4 to 7 in interfering in their life.

Statement of petitioner No.2 was recorded to the effect that he was married with petitioner no.1 with the consent of his parents but the parents of petitioner No.1 were not agree with their marriage. He also stated the parents of petitioner No.1 are now happy with their marriage and he has no more threat to his life and liberty. He has further stated that his wife has gone to Norway.

Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of as having
become infructuous.
