By virtue of the instant petition preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking direction to respondent No.2 to ensure the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondent Nos.3 & 4 as well as to look into the representation filed by them (Annexure P-3).

Notice of motion.

At the asking of Court, Mr. RPS Sidhu, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-Punjab. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.

The contention of the learned counsel for the petitioners is that police is harassing to the petitioners. Even, though a compromise has already been arrived at between the parties.

Learned counsel further contends that a representation dated November 30, 2016 (Annexure P-3) was moved to Commissioner of Police,

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Jalandhar, but till date no action has been taken by the concerned authorities.

The instant petition is disposed of, with a direction to respondent No.2- Commissioner of Police, Jalandhar (Punjab) to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioners in their representation dated November 30, 2016 (Annexure P-3) and if some substance is found, to take an appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
