ANITA CHAUDHRY, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No. 196/2014 dated 10.10.2014 registered at Police Station Model Town, District Hoshiarpur under Section 304-B IPC, 302 IPC (added lateron).

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner was arrested on 10.10.2014 and the deceased had undergone operation in March 2014 and during treatment the doctor had told her that she was unable to conceive and she was under acute depression and had committed suicide.

On 19.01.2016, it had been stated that the wife was getting treatment and husband was in Pune for training during that period. Today, counsel for the petitioner has placed on record the treatment record and the leave record. According to the record produced today the petitioner was on leave from 29.09.2014 to 18.10.2014. It is admitted that the petitioner was at home on the day of incident.

The deceased was married to the petitioner in January 2014.

The incident occurred on 10.10.2014 i.e. within 10 months of the marriage in the matrimonial home. The father-in-law and mother-in-law have now been summoned under Section 319 Cr.P.C. The deceased was operated in March 2014 and the incident is of October 2014 and during this period she was tortured that she put an end to her life. The allegations are serious. No case for bail is made out.

The petition is dismissed.
