This revision petition has been filed against the conviction of the petitioner in a private complaint under Sections 419, 467, 468 of the IPC. The trial Court had convicted him under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471/34 of the IPC but in appeal, the appellate Court acquitted him under Sections 420, 471 of the IPC.

Allegations were that the petitioner had forged a power of

attorney of his brother. The petitioner has undergone about three months

of actual sentence out of total sentence of two years.

On 6.5.2016, the following order was passed :-

“ It appears that possibility of amicable settlement of the dispute needs to be explored. Mater may, thus, be referred to Mediation and Conciliation Centre situated in this Court for alternate dispute resolution. Parties are directed to appear before the said forum on 24.05.2016 and on any other date(s) fixed by the forum.”

Pursuant thereto, the matter has been settled by the Mediation Centre of this Court as per the report dated 11.7.2016. On the last date, learned State counsel had sought time to verify these facts. He states that the above facts are correct.

In this view of the matter, while maintaining conviction and dismissing this petition, sentence of the petitioner is reduced to the period which he has already undergone.
