Kuldip Singh, J. (Oral):

In the present petition, quashing of FIR No.42 dated 26.1.2014 registered under Sections 188, 336, 337 IPC read with Section 25/27/54/59 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Kapurthala City, District Kapurthala, is sought on the basis of compromise.

Learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Kapurthala has reported that the petitioner appeared before him and stated that he has already been acquitted in the impugned FIR, whereas the complainant-victim did not turn despite repeated offers. The learned Magistrate has further reported that the petitioner does not want to pursue the quashing petition.

None has come present to represent the petitioner.

In view of the above, present petition is dismissed for non prosecution.
