Present revision petition has been filed by the accused/petitioner against the judgment of conviction and the order of sentence dated 08.11.2010 passed by the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Faridkot, convicting the petitioner under Section 138 of the Negotiable Instruments Act and sentencing him to undergo rigorous imprisonment for six months and further awarding a compensation of ₹42,000/-, which conviction and sentence was confirmed in appeal by learned Additional Sessions Judge, Faridkot, vide judgment dated 17.02.2012. Aggrieved by the judgments of the Courts below, the petitioner has come up in revision.

It has been stated by the parties and their counsel that the parties have compromised, in which regard statements of the parties have been recorded. Learned counsel for respondent No.1 – Bank has stated that respondent No.1 has no objection if the present revision petition is accepted and the impugned judgments passed by the Courts below are set aside. Learned counsel for respondent No.1 has also placed on record a letter, Ex.CX, issued by the Branch Manager, (The Faridkot Central Co-op. Bank Ltd., B.O Bargarl) in this regard.
