Petitioner seeks concession of regular bail in a case registered at the instance of Sawalia Shah, driver of Ola Taxi Service alleging that on 16.11.2015 on getting booking from some customers, two boys boarded his taxi posing the customers and entered the car and took away the same with the cab of the complainant.

The petitioner was arrested in this case while he was in custody in another FIR.

On the basis of recovery of the car from outside the house of the petitioner, he has been involved in the case.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that on account of dispute between the business of private taxi driver and Ola Taxi Service with professional rivalry, the petitioner has been involved in the case.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and going through the facts and circumstances of the case.

Recovery has already been effected. Challan has already been presented. No useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner in custody.

In view of said circumstances, the petitioner can be granted concession of bail as he has been in custody w.e.f. 14.12.2015.

Petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court.
