This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking a direction to respondents No.2 to 4 to register a criminal case against respondent No.5.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to repeated complaints made by the petitioner, the police neither registered a case nor investigated the same. Thus, appropriate direction needs to be issued.

I find no merit in the plea. Admittedly, petitioner is father-in-law of respondent No.5 and civil dispute is going on between them. Respondent No.5 also filed Crl. Complaint No.101 of 2015, wherein present petitioner was summoned under sections 323/354/34 and 376 read with section 511 IPC by Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Barnala, vide order dated 08.10.2015. It seems that present petition has been filed by the petitioner just to settle scores. Version of the petitioner cannot be

taken as a gospel truth. No case for issuance of direction as prayed for, is made out.
