Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 & 4 to take legal action against private respondents i.e. respondents No.5 & 6.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that he does not press the prayer for registration of case. However, he states that the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), Amritsar to look into the contents of his representation dated 15.12.2016 (Annexure P-2) and to pass appropriate order in accordance with law.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only at this stage.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Gurinderjit Singh, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), Amritsar to look into the contents of petitioner's representation dated 15.12.2016 (Annexure P-2), and to act in accordance with law.
