Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of directions to hand over the investigation in case bearing FIR No. 0290 dated November 21, 2015 under Sections 325, 323, 148 and 149 IPC registered at Police Station Sohana, Distt. SAS Nagar to some senior officer or to direct the concerned Investigating Officer to conduct the investigation in a fair and impartial manner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though in the instant case FIR was registered on November 21, 2015 but no appropriate action has been taken. Even thereafter, a representation dated December 03, 2015 (Anneuxre P-2) was also moved by petitioner to respondent No.2 but till date no action has been taken.

3. Notice of motion.

4. At the asking of Court, Mr. J.S. Sekhon, AAG, Punjab accepts notice

on behalf of respondents. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.

5. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, Punjab to look into the grievances of the petitioner unfolded by him in his representation dated December 03, 2015 (Annexure P-2), specially considering the allegations levelled by the petitioner in the above-mentioned FIR as well as nature of injuries, and in case some substance is found therein, to take action in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
