Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 482 of the Cr.P.C. is for issuance of a direction to the official respondents to protect the lives and liberty of the petitioners and not to harass them at the instance of respondent Nos.4 to 9.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Mr.Sumandeep Singh Walia, DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent Nos.1 to 3.

The petitioners have got married against the wishes of their parents. They are stated to be major. At the time of hearing, true copy of the marriage certificate is produced and photocopy of the same is taken on record. In support of her proof of age, petitioner No.1 has placed on record a copy of Aadhar Card (Annexure P-1) wherein her year of birth is mentioned as 1994, whereas petitioner No.2 has placed on record a copy of Aadhar Card (Annexure P-2) wherein his date of birth is mentioned as 11.4.1995. They have also moved a representation (Annexure P-4) before respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, District Nawanshahar for protection of their lives and liberty.

Without adverting to the merits of the controversy, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, District Nawanshahar to take appropriate action on the said representation.

This order has nothing to do with regard to validity or invalidity of the marriage of the petitioners.
