Instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for issuance of directions to respondents No. 1 to 3 to take appropriate action against the accused for committing cognizable offence regarding which DDR No.38, dated 27.11.2016 (Annexure P-2) has been registered at Police Station Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur and to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No. 4 to 7.

2. Notice of motion to the respondents-State.

3. On the asking of Court, Mr. RPS Sidhu, AAG, Punjab has accepted notice on behalf of respondent-State. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though representation dated 20.11.2016 (Annexure P-3) was moved to Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur as well as Station House Officer, Police

Station Dasuya but till date no action has been taken.

5. The instant petition is disposed of with direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Hoshiarpur to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated 20.11.2016 (Annexure P-3) and if some substance is found, to take appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
