This petition under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure has been filed for quashing of order dated 03.06.2013 (Annexure P-4) passed by learned Chief Judicial Magistrate, Gurgaon whereby the petitioner has been declared proclaimed offender in FIR No.32 dated 13.02.2012 registered under Sections 323, 498-A, 406 and 506 read with Section 34 of the Indian Penal Code (for short 'the IPC'), at Police Station Palam Vihar, Gurgaon, on the basis of compromise.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the parties have compromised the matter vide compromise-deed (Annexure P-2). Vide order of even date, the aforesaid FIR No.32 dated 13.02.2012 has been quashed.

Learned counsel for the State as well as learned counsel for the complainant admit the factum of compromise. Mr. Ramesh Vallabh, father of the complainant is present in the Court and states that the parties have compromised the matter.

In view of the fact that the parties have settled the matter and that the aforesaid FIR No.32 dated 13.02.2012 in which the present order of P.O was passed, stands quashed, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the proceedings alive. Consequently, the present petition is allowed. The order dated 03.06.2013 (Annexure P-4) declaring the petitioner proclaimed offender is quashed.
