By virtue of the instant petition preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking direction to respondent No. 2 to take legal action against respondent No.6.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of Court, Mr. J.S. Sekhon, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-Punjab. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though representation dated October 05, 2016 (Annexure P-4) was moved, but till date no action has been taken by the concerned authorities.

At the very outset of the arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Fatehgarh Sahib (Punjab) to decide his representation dated October 05, 2016 (Annexure P-4) within a stipulated period.

The instant petition is disposed of, with a direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Fatehgarh Sahib (Punjab) to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated October 05, 2016 (Annexure P-4) and if some substance is found, to take an appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
