Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of appropriate directions to the respondents No.2 and 3 for not harassing and victimizing the petitioner unnecessarily at the hands of private respondent No.4, who is Sarpanch of village.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that for the relief claimed in the present petition, the petitioner has already submitted a representation dated 12.11.2016 (Annexure P-2) to the respondent No.2 i.e. Senior Superintendent of Police, Gurdaspur. He further states that at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied in case the respondent No.2 is directed to consider the said representation.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only at this stage.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Gurinderjit Singh, DAG, Punjab

accepts notice on behalf of these respondents.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondent No.2 to look into the contents of aforesaid representation (Annexure P-2) and to act in accordance with law.
