By virtue of instant petition preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C., petitioner has sought directions to respondents to take prompt action, in accordance with law against the accused, in case FIR No. 81, dated 28.06.2016, under Sections 307, 326 (added later on), 324, 341, 148 and 149 IPC, Police Station Division No.2, Pathankot, as even after registration of the FIR no action has been initiated against the accused, who are roaming freely.

Notice of motion to official respondents at this stage only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. J.S. Sekhon, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State of Punjab. Copy of the petition be supplied to learned State counsel during the course of day.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though representation dated November 03, 2016 (Annexure P-3) was moved, but till date no substantive action has been taken by the concerned authorities.

The instant petition is disposed of, with a direction to respondent No.2- Senior Superintendent of Police, Pathankot (Punjab) to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated November 03, 2016 (Annexure P-3) and if some substance is found, to take an appropriate action in accordance with law within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
