ANITA CHAUDHRY, J(ORAL)

The petitioner is the son of respondent. The trial Court allowed the prayer for interim maintenance and a sum of Rs.1,200/- per month was allowed from the date of application. The order was confirmed by the Revisional Court.

The submission on behalf of the petitioner is that the petition had been filed as a counter blast to the suit filed by the petitioner in which stay was granted. The counsel further submits that the mother was getting pension and this fact had not been disclosed. The counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner had got appointment on compassionate grounds in lieu of the services rendered by his father.

The petitioner is unmarried and is getting salary of more than Rs.13,000/- per month. Only a small amount of Rs.1,200/- per month has been allowed as interim maintenance. The trial Court had referred to the fact

that the mother is getting monthly pension of Rs.8,486/-. It had also noted that on account of the old age, she needs extra funds for her medicines and maintenance. The Court had also noted that she was getting treatment in Mohan Das Poswal Hospital, Ludhiana. The petitioner has not paid any amount till now. I find no infirmity in the order.

The petition is dismissed in limine.
