Prayer made in the present petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for directing the respondents No.1 to 4 not to call the petitioner in the police station without registration of any case and not to harass him.

Learned counsel for the State, on the strength of the reply dated 13.07.2015 filed on behalf of respondents No. 1 to 3 by way of affidavit of Jaskiranjit Singh Teja, PPS, Superintendent of Police(I) Distt. Patiala, states that the petitioner was summoned to the police station for inquiry into the complaint made by respondent No.5 in which the statement of the petitioner was also recorded. Besides this, the petitioner was never summoned to the police station or threatened to be implicated in false case/FIR as alleged by the petitioner.

In view of the reply so furnished by respondent-State, no cause of action survives with the petition.
